Paris Information Evening

GHIC Cards (Global Health Insurance Card)

All pupils will require a GHIC card for the visit. If your child already has a GHIC card, we will need to take this with us on the visit. Please provide this to the academy office as soon as possible, and by no later than 6th March 2024.

If your child does not currently have a GHIC card, please apply for one as soon as possible. The card is free via the NHS and applications should be made online at https://www.nhs.uk/using-the-nhs/healthcare-abroad/apply-for-a-free-uk-global-health-insurance-cardghic/. Once your child receives their GHIC card, please hand this into the academy office as soon as possible.

Spending Money

Parents may now wish to consider making arrangements for their child to have spending money for the visit. This is by no means an expectation as the full visit is a wonderful experience without the need to purchase souvenirs. If you would like to send your child with spending money, we ask that you send in no more than €60 in cash (already in euro notes please), in a named envelope/money bag, to the academy office by no later than the 6th March 2024. More detail of spending money will be shared at the information evening.
